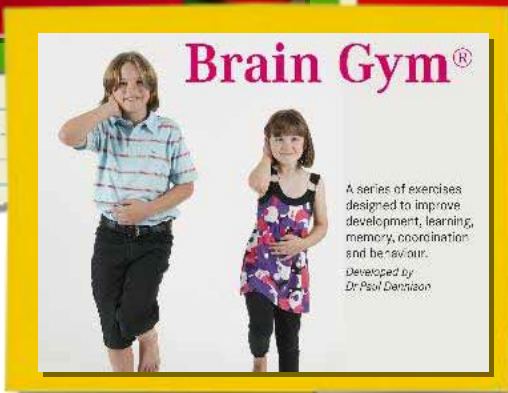
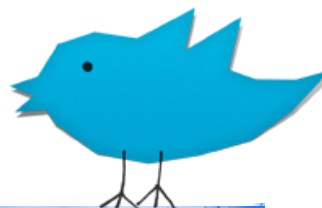

The Kinetics Active Learning Program provides a unique and active setting where children participate in both structured and free play experiences that enhance your child’s cognitive, social, emotional, and physical skills. Your child will be given many opportunities to create, discover, imagine, problem solve, and explore. Our activities will foster a healthy self esteem, independence, and compassion for others.

The day is filled with movement, excitement, and close interaction with teachers and each other. This close interaction builds trust and respect which in turn allows us to build positive behavior, self-esteem, and confidence.

Our unique program goes beyond regular reading, writing and arithmetic to build a child from the inside-out. We start the day with simple exercises to stimulate brain function. These exercises address specific dimensions of physical movement that correlate with areas of the brain that are used for focus, concentration, comprehension, and communication.

Included throughout our day is reading, writing, creative arts, science, social studies, and math. These educational portions of our day include traditional literacy and mathematics as well as non-traditional learning that involve fun games played specifically for learning. Children interact closely with teachers and peers during edu-games. They have hands-on fun while learning rather than sitting for long periods at a desk and trying to finish worksheets alone.

Examples of our edu-learning include: Learning letters – children will run to pick up beanbags with the letters A, C and R and T. Then together with teacher and friends, they make as many words as they can in 5 minutes. Not only are they learning the letter, they learn that the letters when put together make a word they know. Brilliant!

## PROGRAM DETAILS

We focus on physical, social, emotional and cognitive development as well as academic development. A whole child approach is taken with an emphasis on brain and physical development.

### BRAIN AND PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

Thirty minutes a day is dedicated to doing brain exercises and Yoga poses. These exercises are a combination of the Brain Gym®, Power Brain Education® by Ilchi Lee, and other great books and programs.

### CREATIVE ARTS

Creative arts includes clay molding, drawing, painting, theater, expression, dance, and music & movement. Each day kids will experience new creative ways to express and feel good about themselves.

### READING/WRITING

Pre-reading activities include: phonics, letter and number awareness, story time, as well as critical thinking and comprehension techniques. Pre-writing activities include: small motor skills and strengthening exercises, and imaginative thinking exercises.

### MATH/SCIENCE

Number identification, pattern recognition, counting, skip counting, number games, calendar activities, telling time, and money games. The way we teach math is active and fun so kids understand the concepts as well as visual recognition of numbers and problems.
